

The English Placement Test (*Beykoz-PLET*) is held at the beginning of each academic year in order to determine the students who must study in the English Preparatory Program and to place them in classes appropriate to their level. *Beykoz-PLET* consists of multiple-choice questions ranging in level from A1 (beginner) to B2 (upper-intermediate). The exam assesses students' various language skills (such as listening, reading, vocabulary and grammar). Students whose exam results are B1 (intermediate) and above are entitled to take the English Proficiency Exam (*Beykoz-PROF*) to be held after this exam. According to the results of *Beykoz-PROF*, they will be exempt from the English Preparatory Program or if they cannot meet the necessary conditions, they will be assigned to the class determined in line with their *Beykoz-PLET* results.
