

## **2023-2024 Fall Term Erasmus+ Student Mobility for Studies and Student Mobility for Placement Application Announcement**

**Students will be sent abroad within the scope of Erasmus+ Student Mobility for Studies and Mobility for Placement.**

Scope of Erasmus + Student Studies and Placement Mobility For the 2023-2024 Fall Semester, the applicants who have the following European centers that we have contracted with or who want to do internship will go abroad.

- Study Mobility Quota 6 for the 2022 Grant Contract, Internship Mobility Quota 1.

### **Application conditions:**

- At any of the formal education levels within the student's higher education institution
- (first, second or third cycle) enrolled in a higher education program, full-time
- being a student,,
- Must be at least a 2nd year student when abroad,
- Having a cumulative grade point average of at least 2.20/4.00,
- Have enough ECTS credits for mobility,
- If the current departments have benefited from higher education mobility within the Erasmus+ and Lifelong Learning (LLP) period, the total duration of the new activity should not exceed 12 months.

### **Informations:**

- Applications will be made between 25.04.2023 and 10.05.2023.
- Applications will be made online at <https://erasmusbasvuru.ua.gov.tr/giris?returnUrl=%2F> and <https://form.beykoz.edu.tr/2023-2024-erasmus-ogrenci-ogrenim-ve-staj-hareketliligi-basvuru-formu/> .
- Students must fill in the application completely by 16.00 on 10.05.2023 at the latest.
- There are online application upload formulas for the TOEFL, PTE or equivalent exam results approved by YÖK, and transcripts showing the foreign language exams, if any.
- Applications made after this target will not be considered.
- Late/early applications with missing documents will not be accepted.

### **Criteria when evaluating applications:**

**Total 100 points;**

- Academic success level: 50%
- Language level: 50%

<i>For mobile selected students: Not participating in meetings/trainings organized by the higher education institution with a mobile interest (applicable if the student applies for Erasmus again)</i>	<i>-5 Points</i>

*Not taking the language exam without an excuse (applicable if the student re-applies to Erasmus)*

**-5 Points**

- Students studying in a double major can apply for mobility from only one major in the same application period.
- Among the students whose applications are evaluated and accepted, those who do not have any foreign language proficiency certificate will take the Foreign Language Proficiency exam online at **14.00** on **11.05.2023**. **Microphone and camera will be used in the exam.**
- Students who are in the last year of their undergraduate period can only apply for placement mobility. They can do internship mobility within 12 months after graduation.
