APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

Candidates must have completed their undergraduate degree in order to apply to the Psychology Master's Programs.

Candidates applying to Psychology Thesis and Non-Thesis Master's Programs must have a bachelor's degree in psychology or PDR. Applications of candidates with a bachelor's degree from other fields will be deemed invalid and will not be evaluated.

- Candidates applying to the program with thesis must have at least 55 points in the ALES result in the Equal Weight point type. (The validity period of ALES results is 5 years.).

APPLICATION PROCESS

Online Application and Submission of Application Documents

Applications are made through the online application link on the web page of Beykoz University Graduate Programs Institute. Application documents can be uploaded to the system during the online application process or missing documents can be uploaded by logging back into the system with the pin code sent to the e-mail address specified in the application after the application is completed. APPLICATION DOCUMENTS

During the application process, candidates must upload their application documents in full. Applications of candidates with incomplete application documents will not be evaluated.

EVALUATION PROCESS

Science Exam

- The science exam will be conducted online on Monday, 9 October 2023.
- Candidates who meet the application requirements and submit the application documents in full are entitled to take the science exam.
- The candidates who are entitled to participate in the science exams will be announced on the website of the Graduate Programs Institute on Friday, 6 October 2023. The science exam announcement will be sent by the Graduate Programs Institute to the e-mail address specified in the online application form of the candidates who are entitled to participate in the science exams.
- The scope of the science exam includes psychology undergraduate courses.
- The passing grade of the science exam is at least 50 points.

Interview

- Interviews will be held online/online via Zoom platform between 10-11 October 2023.
- Candidates who are eligible to participate in the interview will be announced on the web page of the Graduate School of Graduate Programs on October 9, 2023. The interview announcement will be sent to the e-mail address specified in the online application form of the candidates who are eligible to participate in the interview, together with Zoom links and related instructions (interview time, etc.) by the Graduate School of Graduate Programs.
- The interview grade is evaluated out of 100 full grades.

Ranking of the Candidates Accepted

After the interviews, the candidates will be ranked from the highest score to the lowest score. The Council of Higher Education (YÖK) Equivalencies table will be used for undergraduate grade point average. The principles to be applied in the ranking of success are as follows.

Candidates with Turkish Nationality:

For Master's program with thesis,

The success level grade of the candidates who are successful in the science exam and interview consists of the sum of 50% of the ALES score, 20% of the undergraduate graduation success grade and 30% of the interview grade.

For the Non-Thesis Master's program,

The success level grade of the candidates who are successful in the science exam and interview is calculated as 30% of the interview grade and 70% of the undergraduate graduation success grade.

Foreign National Candidates:

For Master's program with thesis,

The success level grade of the candidates who are successful in the science exam and interview is calculated as 70% of the undergraduate graduation success grade and 30% of the interview grade.

For the Non-Thesis Master's program,

The success level grade of the candidates who are successful in the science exam and interview is calculated as 70% of the undergraduate graduation success grade and 30% of the interview grade.

Announcement of the Accepted Candidates with the Right for Final Registration and Registration Dates

- After the completion of the evaluation process with the science exam and interview, the candidates who are entitled to final registration will be announced by the Graduate Education Institute on Friday, 13 October 2023.
- In Psychology Programs, the first program chosen by the candidates who apply to both the thesis and non-thesis programs are accepted as their first choice, and the candidates who have the right to enroll in both programs are placed in their first preference.

- Candidates on the primary accepted list will complete the final registration process between 16-18 October 2023.
- After the registration period of the candidates accepted in the primary list has been completed, the final registration process of the candidates on the waiting list will be carried out on 19-20 October 2023, according to the number of quotas remaining.

FINAL REGISTRATION

Candidates must first pay the program fee and complete their financial approval for the final registration to the programs they are accepted to.

Tuition Fee and Financial Confirmation

2023-2024 academic year Psychology Thesis and Non-Thesis Master's Program fees are as follows. There is no scholarship application in our Psychology Programs.
